

Information for scouts, leaders and parents regarding the January 15, 2011 Girl Scout Day

The next Girl Scout Day will be held January 15, 2011, from 10am until 2pm. Lunches may be brought with you and eaten in the town park (next door to the lighthouse). There are rest rooms and water fountains on the lighthouse grounds.

This event was created to give area Girl Scouts the opportunity to learn about Florida Lighthouses and lighthouse history. Badges were created for Brownies, Juniors and Cadet's/Seniors and Ambassadors, with various badge requirements able to be met on January 15th. When you arrive, go to the tent in front of the Gift Shop, and pick up your packet of information (Workshop Schedule, Requirements Sheet, etc.) Participants and chaperons should plan to spend approximately four hours at the Lighthouse during this program. Time will be made available to attend all workshops, climb the tower, and see all the museum buildings.

Please Note: No water bottles, food or back packs are allowed on the museum grounds. Water fountains are located throughout the facility for your convenience.

This event is designed to be a fun outing at the lighthouse. Participants will be placed in groups according to their level (Brownies, Juniors, and Cadets/Seniors/Ambassadors) if overall attendance exceeds 100 participants.

Upon arrival you will receive a schedule that will direct your **GROUP** to the appropriate workshop. The workshop schedule is very generous time-wise, with plenty of time to visit the other museum buildings and climb the lighthouse tower. After each workshop, the scouts will get their "Requirements Sheet" stamped.

Brownies - Try-It Badge

Brownies will be able to complete all four of their Try-It badge requirements on January 16th, and may purchase their Try-It badge, for \$1.00, at the entrance tent (while supplies last).

Juniors - Proficiency Badge

Juniors will be able to complete four of the six requirements for their Proficiency Badge. Forms to order the Proficiency Badge will be available at the entrance tent.

Cadet's/Seniors/Ambassadors - Interest Project Award

The girls will be able to complete five of the seven requirements for their Interest Project Award. Forms to order the Project Award will be available at the entrance tent.
